October is National Domestic Violence Awareness Month. This year, as a part of our Community Service Program's outreach efforts, we are happy to announce that **we are helping Secure the Call, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, collect used cell phones and tablets.** Secure the Call converts donated devices into 911 emergency-only phones, which are given out to their Community Partners across the USA at no charge.

Secure the Call's goal is to collect 10,000 devices during October. We are delighted to be a part of their efforts to help at-risk women.

We have set up a drop-off box at (insert location) so that you can donate your old cell phones and chargers to this wonderful cause.

Secure the Call is a National Coalition of over 350 organizations, including Police and Sheriff's Departments (Victim Services Department), Domestic Violence Shelters, and Senior Citizen groups, demonstrating a need for emergency 911-only cell phones and tablets.

Secure the Call collects these devices and clears them of any service, numbers, and address books. The phones are then reprogrammed to be able to dial 911 without a service contract and then are sent back out to their Coalition of Partners throughout the USA, who, in turn, distribute them for free to local communities.

Your help is greatly needed and appreciated. Please bring in your old devices from home and drop them off at our collection box. Your device will go a long way to making sure high-risk individuals always have access to emergency services.
